

Shurijo Castle Park is a splendid place to visit even at night!

Between August and September, the park is open until 20:30.
The view at night from the castle that stands on a hill is exceptional.

By the time that night falls, the sweltering heat goes away, and a cool breeze blows through the park.

If you stand on the Iri-no-Azana (an observation deck located on the west-side of the castle walls), the skyline that is stained by the setting sun and the Naha cityscape will surely become unforgettable memories for you. (Sunset time: August/ 18:51 to 19:17, September/ 18:18 to 18:50)



Exhibitions are always held in the Nanden special exhibition room and the Kugani-udun special exhibition room. If you visit at a time when the torrent of visitors has trickled down, you may hear a voice whispering the history of the Ryukyu Kingdom.



As you pass through Hoshinmon Gate, Shurijo Castle Seiden appears before your eyes. In the slightly magical atmosphere of dusk, you will feel struck by an illusion as if you had arrived in a different world.



Shurijo Castle is lighted up in the evening as soon as the sun sets. Quite different from the daytime where the vermilion castle is set off against the blue sky, the entire park is enveloped in a fantastical atmosphere. (Light-up time: Sunset to 24:00)
