1 Kid's Corner

The Kid's Corner inside the Park Information Center (Haisai Plaza). While looking at the overwhelming power of the whale shark, illustrated on the walls, picture books and video contents can be enjoyed. There is also a space where children can play while parents can relax yet keep their eye on them at all times. *Aimed at children up to 12 years old (until the end of elementary school).

7 Meet the World Cultural Experience room

The experience room inside of the Oceanic Culture Museum. Along with real materials used by villagers and toys made out of wood, children, along with their parents, can enjoy the experience transmitted through all five senses.

11 Aqua Town

At the setting Sunset Square there is a playground with 43 different pieces of equipment installed. A tube slider (tunnel) where your voice and other sounds can be sent to another location, and a lookout (with binoculars) as well as many other attractions await.

6 Riding Ground (Playground)

Inside the riding grounds of the Native Okinawa Village, surrounded by trees and nature, there is a 50m rock climbing wall to climb, and while playing, one can further develop their strength.

8 Kids' Adventure Land

Close to the Okinawa Churaumi Aquarium is the largest net-playground area in Japan. Using the Okinawa sea as a theme, there is a ripple zone, a Japanese current zone, an ocean zone, and a deep sea zone, representing the 4 aquatic areas of the region.
