9 Tropical & Subtropical Arboretum

Haisai Plaza → 21-min.walk / 1,800m

Many different plant types can be observed here, and in a playful way you can learn many things.



5 Tropical Dream Center

Haisai Plaza → 7-min.walk / 580m

Tropical fruits and plants are in abundance! From the outlook, you can take in the beautiful scenery.



7 Oceanic Culture Museum (Planetarium)

Haisai Plaza → 2-min.walk / 150m

Starting from a collection of valuable canoes, over 750 items related to the local maritime culture can be seen here. In the connected planetarium hall, films are screened, with topics such as stargazing and what can be seen during the current season.



11 Sunset Square & View Resthouse

Haisai Plaza → 15-min.walk / 1,080m

A place where, on a clear day you can see the beautiful sunset and all the surrounding scenery in one sweeping view, and there are areas provisioned for you to take a rest at, or places like Aqua Town where children can enjoy themselves, all in one connected area. Inside, there is an area with a collection of botanical literature, named "The Green Library".



6 Native Okinawa Village & Omoro Botanical Garden

Haisai Plaza → 3-min.walk / 170m

The Ryukyu Kingdom Era has revived, featuring village houses, and worship places like the "Utaki", and "Uganju". In addition, you'll see the Omoro Botanical Garden exhibits plants described in the "Omoro-soushi", a collection of songs and poems.



2 Okinawa Churaumi Aquarium

Haisai Plaza → 5-min.walk / 350m

The majestic world of Okinawa's mysterious creatures unfolds, allowing visitors to experience the Okinawan sea in its entirety.

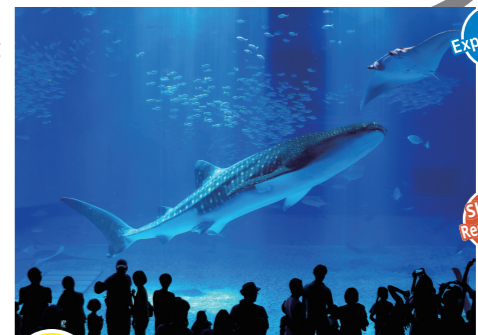


3 Emerald Beach

Haisai Plaza → 14-min.walk / 1,200m

An emerald green and cobalt blue open sea. Emerald beach is a beach within a lagoon, which is rare for even Okinawa.
